- Exit on Marshall Road (Co. Rd. 17); turn left (south)
- Go 1-1/3 miles to Co. Rd. 78 and turn right
- Follow 78 west 34 mile to Co. Rd. 79
- Turn left on 79 (south)
- Go 34 mile to Stonebrooke Golf Club

Shotgun Start: 12:00PM/NOON. Please arrive by 10:45AM for check-in. **Lunch will not be provided.**



From East

From the airport, take I-494 West and exit at Highway 100 North. Exit at Industrial Boulevard and the hotel will be located directly off of the exit.

From North

Take Interstate 35W South to Highway 62 West. Take Highway 100 South to Industrial Blvd. and the hotel is located on the right.

From West

Take I-494 South to Highway 100 North. Exit at Industrial Blvd. and the hotel will be located directly off of the exit.

From South

Take 35W North to Interstate 494 West and then to Highway 100 North. Exit at Industrial Blvd. and the hotel will be located directly off of the exit.
